DOG LICENSE RENEWALS

FYI – dog license renewals are due now. We will need to inventory all pets in the city to update our list. There is a renewal sheet on back side of this sheet. Please provide your pet's information, a tag number from a tag issued by the City in the past or if you need one sent, and vaccination verification letter from your vet. Any tags issued by the city are permanent – they do not get replaced each year.

WILDLIFE CONTROL

We often receive calls regarding non-domestic (wild) animals seen on private property. Please note that **the City does not have the equipment, resources, or authority to remove wild animals** from public or private property.

If you are experiencing issues with wild animals causing property damage, the appropriate agency to contact is the **Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR)**.

Dog License Update/Renewal/Registration Form

The City of Goodhue is doing a full audit of dogs in city limits and renewing dog licenses for 2025. Pursuant to City Code 91.02, if you have a dog at your residence, a dog license is required and failure to have your dog licensed with the City of Goodhue could be subject to a maximum penalty of \$700 fine or 90-day imprisonment or both. Please cut and fill out the form below and return it with your \$10/dog fee as well as a copy of your current rabies certificate that shows the period of rabies coverage for your dog(s). **Renewals must be received by June 30, 2025.** Licenses are effective July 1st – June 30th yearly and are not transferable or refundable. If you have any questions regarding your renewal or the animal code, please contact the clerk at 923-4310 or cityclerk@ci.goodhue.mn.us.
